906.01 Description. This work shall consists of the excavation for and the placing of specified stone material and the disposal of the surplus excavated material as shown on the plans and where placed as ordered in writing by the Engineer. The purpose of this work is to provide a suitable subgrade for the pipe and appurtenant structures. Compact or consolidate the stone or gravel used as foundation material in such a manner and to provide adequate support for the over-lying structure or material.

The City will not pay separately for placing stone foundation to provide the water free trench as specified by Section 901.16.

906.02 Materials. Use the following materials:

- **906.03 Method of Measurement.** The Engineer will measure and accept stone foundation by the number of cubic yards (cubic meters) placed, calculated within the authorized excavation limits, as shown on the plans or as ordered in writing by the Engineer.
- **906.04 Basis of Payment.** The City will pay the accepted number of cubic yards (cubic meters) of stone foundation measured at the contract unit price per cubic yard (cubic meter). The City will not pay for excavation or material outside the authorized limits.
