NHTSA, Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) Course (OVI-4)



Course Purpose / Objectives:

This course provides a review of the SFST administration, as well as an overview of seven drug categories as used in the Drug Evaluation and Classification program. This course focuses upon the drugged driver by providing the officer with relevant information including signs of impairment, other roadside testing that can be used to document impairment, and the utilization of Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) officers. This course is described as "bridging the gap" between impaired driving enforcement involving alcohol or drugs. This course is limited to thirty (30) officers. Course enrolment is open to outside agencies.

Prerequisite:

Completion of Advanced Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (OVI-2) Course.

There is no cost to attend this course.
