Incident Summary: ****Update: On April 24, 2024, Murder charges were filed on the suspect, Marvin Holt M/B/17, who was identified as being responsible for the murder of Larry Edwards. Marvin Holt is currently in custody at the Franklin County Juvenile Detention Center.***

On January 29, 2024, at 10:33 PM, Columbus Police officers were dispatched to Nationwide Children's Hospital to investigate a shooting. Upon arrival, the officers found one victim, identified as LARRY E.R. EDWARDS, M/W/41, suffering from a gunshot wound. EDWARDS self-transported to the hospital after being shot while driving a vehicle in the 400 block of Parsons Av. Despite life-saving measures, EDWARDS was pronounced deceased at 11:01 PM.

Next of kin notification has been made. At this time, the motive is unknown. The investigation continues.
