Incident Summary: On April 16, 2024 at approximately 12:20 p.m., an unknown suspect entered the Huntington bank located in the 2000 block of Bethel Road, approached the teller counter and passed a demand note for money. The suspect threatened the victim teller. The teller complied with the demand and gave the suspect an undetermined amount of cash. The suspect fled toward a white SUV parked in an adjacent parking lot just east of the bank. A dye pack exploded prior to the suspect entering the SUV. The suspect got into the vehicle and was last seen driving eastbound on Bethel Road.

The suspect wore black clothing with a tan hat.
