Incident Summary: *Update: January 7, 2024, the victim of this incident has been identified as Yahya Mohamad, and the next of kin notification has been made.*****

On January 4, 2024, at approximately 8:13 a.m., patrol officers were dispatched to the 1800 block of Belcher Dr. on an unresponsive male. Once officers arrived, they found the victim, rendered aid, and summoned fire personnel to assist. Unfortunately, the individual succumbed to his injury and was pronounced deceased at 8:19 a.m. by CFD Medic 24 personnel. The identity of the decedent is being withheld pending notification of the next of kin. During the investigation, it was determined that suspect had intervened in a theft from a motor vehicle when the victim was shot.
