## **Incident Summary:**

\*\*\*UPDATE: Detectives have filed Murder charges against Tyreese Fields, 19, for his role in causing Simington's death. Fields has been arrested and is currently incarcerated in the Franklin County Jail.\*\*\*

\*\*\*UPDATE: Detectives have filed a warrants charging 22-year-old William Smith Jr. with Murder and Aggravated Burglary and will seek an indictment for Murder against 25-year-old Earnest Hall for causing Simington's death. Both Smith and Hall are currently incarcerated in the Franklin County Jail.\*\*\*

\*\*\*UPDATE: On October 5, 2022 at 4:32pm, adult #1, Daeshawn Simington, 25, succumbed his injuries and was pronounced deceased.\*\*\*

October 4, 2022 at approximately 10:56pm, Columbus Police Officers were called to the 600 block of E. Morrill Ave on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers found Adult #1 suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. A second victim, adult #2 was located nearby also suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. Both victims were transported by Columbus Fire Medics to a nearby hospital.

Adult #1 and adult #2 were involved in an altercation with a third individual when shots were fired and the victims were struck. Following the shooting the unknown suspect fled from the area.

Due to the severity of adult #1's injuries, the CPD Homicide Unit is investigating this incident. Adult #2's condition is currently stable.
