Incident Summary: On 9/18/2023 at 11:00pm, a pedestrian was attempting to cross E. Broad St. at Hoffman Ave. They were within a marked crosswalk with yellow flashing lights provided. At the same time an unknown vehicle was westbound on E. Broad St. and struck the pedestrian. The unknown vehicle did not stop and continued westbound out of the area. CFD Medic #1 transported the pedestrian to Grant Medical Center in life threatening condition. The pedestrian's injuries would indicate that they were walking northbound across E. Broad St. The pedestrian remains in life threatening condition at Grant.

The Columbus Police Accident Investigation Unit responded to the crash scene and initiated an investigation which in ongoing.
