Foreclosure Form

Per Columbus City Code 1105.045 the deed holder of a property is responsible for the property's unpaid water bills. When a property is in foreclosure the deed transfer process can be slow and sometimes does not occur until the property is re-sold. Therefore, we need the following information before we can remove your name from the water account.

If this date is not included in the letter we will need to final your account as of the date we receive the letter and you will be responsible for any unpaid bills prior to the date we receive this completed form.
