1. The registered design professionals involved in the design of their project are permitted to act as special inspectors and their personnel are permitted to act as special inspectors for the work designed by them, provided they qualify as special inspectors.
2. At least three years of relevant work experience or training in the inspection, testing and evaluation process.
3. Registered design professionals are exempt from required certifications where required experience is met. This exception does not apply to steel construction (welding).
4. Equivalent experience or certifications may be considered.
5. CWI would pertain to any certification accredited by the American Welding Society.
